

How to organise and use your locker

You might use a locker or a tub in your classroom to keep your things organised. No matter where you keep them, this is your space. The goal? Make it easy to find what you need, when you need it.

Easy ways to keep your locker neat

- Put things you use every day in the same spot
- Keep things you don't use every day somewhere else, like spare pencils or your lunchbox
- Try not to overfill your space, less is easier to find
- Always put things back in the same place.



Make things easier to suit your vision

- Use different textures or labels so you can tell things apart
- Use raised stickers, large print or bump dots to mark different sections
- Keep similar things grouped together (all books together, all textas together)
- Use bright colours where you can.



Keep it simple

- Put things back after you use them
- Do a quick check before you leave school so you're ready for the next day
- If something changes, like getting a bigger pencil case, find a new spot for it.

One thing for you to do

Pick one spot for your books, pencil case or lunchbox and always put it back there this week.

It's okay if things feel tricky at first. Ask for help when you need it, take your time and remember that learning new things takes practice. Keeping things in the same place every day will help make finding them easier.
